Goals


- 1. Engage people in Europe's rich artistic history







#Europeana280 / Art History Collections @ Europeana

Europeana 280 @ is a pan-European campaign to get people excited about Europe's shared art heritage by celebrating the diverse and magnificent artworks that are a part of it. The campaign coincides with the launch of the Art History collections one of Europeana's first thematic collection sites. All 28 EU Member States were invited to nominate 10 pieces of art held in their country that have contributed to a major European art movement. Every EU member state is involved, and Norway too!

As part of Europeana 280, we are running the Europeana Art History Challenge!

Artworks: 300 items. Ten from each participating country.

Languages: 39 Wikipedias' are being tracked. Other Wikipedia communities are also welcome to join!

Total: Over 10,000 language-artwork pairs in Wikipedia, and their Wikidata items!

- When: From 15 April until 30 May 2016
- How:
 - Sign up! list your country, and register your points.
 - Create or improving articles on Wikipedia about your country's 10 artworks in your own language.
 - Translate articles about the other country's artworks into your language.
 - Improving the Wikidata about the artworks and any Wikidata item linked from the artwork item.
 - Prizes for overall and national winners!




