#### Details:

The evaluation and potential update of the accreditation scheme is part of the Implementation Plan for the Data Space and relates to the overall question of governance of the Data Space in the future. This also might have an impact on how the EAF's collaboration with the Europeana Foundation (EF) and the Europeana Network Association (ENA) will be structured in the future, which connects the accrediation scheme to the question of the EAF potentially becoming its own legal entity, similar to ENA. In this session we want to come to a common understanding of what we, as aggregators, think are the strengths and weaknesses of the current set-up and what we might want to see as an impact from the aggregators and for the aggregators in the future.
