ENUMERATE Core Survey 3 call for participation

The ENUMERATE Core Survey 3 is open for participation on www.enumerate.eu. All European cultural heritage institutions are encouraged to contribute. The survey includes questions about your digitisation efforts, available collections online and offline, policy on digital collections, sustainability and costs. The survey is organised by ENUMERATE as part of Europeana. It will be distributed among thousands of institutions across Europe. Together we can make the case for investments in our digital activities!

What is in it for you?

The more institutions participate, the more reliable will be our results. The survey will be available from February 27 to the end of March. Thousands of cultural heritage institutions participated in the first two editions. We need you to share your relevant key indicators (anonymously) and in return, we will share the (anonymised) results of the survey with all participating organisations.
