By doing so, you will be able to take part in our Members Council elections, as well as run as a candidate to represent your peers yourself. We will also invite you to start helping us shape next year's business plan too.

If you have not registered as a member of the Association and received your Network Membership ID before **30 September**, you will not be able to take part in key decisions such as voting in this year's Members Council elections.

Working to become an Association has been a rewarding and collaborative process, and we are excited about what the future holds. We look forward to welcoming you to the Europeana Association.
