1. Executive Summary

The Europeana Newspapers project aims at the aggregation and refinement of newspapers for <u>The European Library</u> and <u>Europeana</u>. In addition, the project addresses challenges particularly linked with digitized newspapers:

- use of refinement methods for OCR, OLR/article segmentation, and named entity recognition (NER), and page class recognition to enhance search and presentation functionalities for Europeana customers,
- quality evaluation for automatic refinement technologies,
- transformation of local metadata to the Europeana Data Model (EDM)
- metadata standardization in close collaboration with stakeholders from the public and private sector.

The consortium will provide more than 18 million newspaper pages to the Europeana service.

- to provide necessary contact details of the project






3. Website structure description






3.2 Consortium

- "Associated partners" with the information on benefits of being an associated partner and with links to the associated partners' homepages








3.3 News

This category is a chronological feed of news items, announcing the news of the project.








3.4 Activities

- Presence at external events info about past and also partly about planned events, where the project has been / is going to be presented.








3.6 Public Materials
