

Europeana Publishing Framework: Content

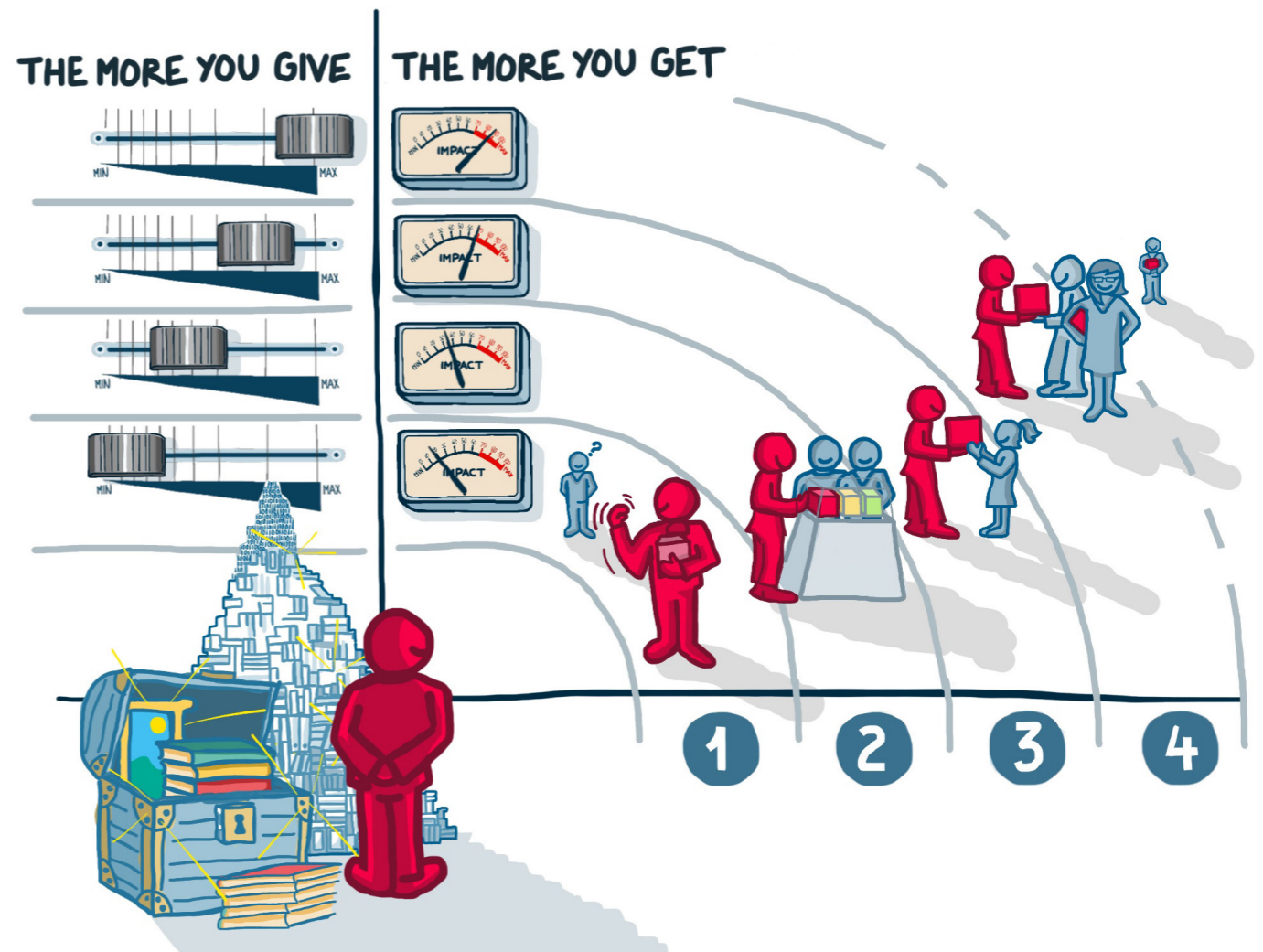
Quick Summary

The Europeana Publishing Framework makes it easy for you, our data partners, to see how the quality of the content and metadata you provide affects how we can surface, showcase and promote it on Europeana Collections and beyond, and how others can view it, share it and work with it.

The framework has **four tiers of criteria** relating to the quality of the content and its licensing, and three tiers relating to the quality of the related metadata were added in July 2018.

What data partners provide will depend on their own agendas and capabilities, but **the higher the quality of information provided, the more benefit created for audiences and the greater the potential** use in education, research and the creative industries.

The content tiers are based on real examples and were developed in wide-ranging discussion under the Europeana Creative project and with the Europeana Network Content Re-use Task Force.
